PCQHA CALIFORNIA STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS

October 3-7, 2018 Paso Robles, CA in conjunction with the Fall Classic Quarter Horse Show & Futurities

Fast FAQ:

1. What are the California State Championships? A California Championship-style event for PCQHA exhibitors held in conjunction with the Fall Classic Quarter Horse Show & Futurities.

2. How can I qualify? California State Qualifiers are selected from a set of core classes from the year-end PCQHA points (Example: For the 2018 California State Championships, the top 20 exhibitors are chosen from each 2017 year-end core class exhibitor based on the year-end standings).

3. Where are the California State Championships held? The 2018 California State Championships are held in conjunction with the Fall Classic Quarter Horse Show & Futurities at the newly renovated Paso Robles Events Center in Paso Robles, CA.

4. Which core classes are included?

- Showmanship
- Western Pleasure
- Western Horsemanship
- Hunter Under Saddle
- Hunt Seat Equitation
- Trail
- Ranch Riding

5. Which divisions will be offered?

- Novice Youth (L1)
- Novice Amateur (L1)
- Youth
- Amateur
- Select Amateur

6. What are the prizes for California State Champions? Beautiful Silverado Silver Buckles will be given to each California State Champion in each class.



7. What is the entry fee for each class? Each class entry fee is \$50.

8. What happens if I am a youth, but will graduate to Amateur at time of show?

You will remain a youth at the California State Championship Show, even though you are an Amateur in all AQHA classes.

9. What happens if I have a different horse? Qualifying is by horse and rider combination, so there are no substitutions of horse or rider.

10. Where can I find out class times? All California State Championship show information will be listed on the PCQHA Fall Classic Website, **PCQHAFallClassic.com**

11. Refunds: No refunds will be given after the entry deadline unless a vet certificate is presented to the show manager or emailed to office@pcqha.com at least 24 hours prior to the start of the show.
