

## Notice!

A choice for all PCQHA Select Amateurs

PCQHA membership has spoken and a new opportunity for Select Amateur's is being offered.

**A Select Amateur may now choose if they would like their points to be allocated to the Amateur OR Select Amateur category for PCQHA year-end awards.**

Currently, once an amateur turns 50 their PCQHA points automatically fall into the Select category. For 2016, Select Amateurs can choose to opt out of the Select Amateur category and earn points in the amateur category.

### **Please read carefully -**

The deadline is June 30, 2016 to notify the PCQHA office if you would like to compete in the Amateur category for PCQHA year-end awards this year

If you choose as a Select Amateur to ride in the Amateur class - you must ride in the Amateur class to earn points. **You may not ride in a Select class and have your points allocated to the Amateur division.** If the Select and Amateur are combined the class then becomes an Amateur class and your points will go the Amateur division.

You must stay in your division on all horses shown.

You must remain in your division for the year. In 2017 when membership applications are sent, you may again choose your division. Note - All selects are automatically placed in the Select Division unless you opt out.

This rule only affects PCQHA points. As an Amateur you may if eligible, compete in the Select division to earn AQHA points - however, you will not earn PCQHA points.
